

The Institute of Metabolic and Cardiovascular Diseases (I2MC) is recruiting a Director for the 2027-2031 term of office.

Located on the Rangueil university hospital site in Toulouse, the **I2MC** (www.i2mc.fr, X account: @I2mcT), a joint Inserm-University of Toulouse III -Paul Sabatier- research unit, employs more than 280 people (researchers, doctors, pharmacists, engineers, technicians, students, post-docs and administrative staff). The 14 internationally recognized research teams study metabolic, vascular, cardiac and renal functions in physiological and pathological contexts, using molecular, cellular and integrated approaches supported by 6 cutting-edge technological platforms. In a scientific, clinical and technological environment of excellence, the I2MC is developing a strong translational activity towards the hospital (clinical trials, serum library, tissue library, etc.) and towards industry. The I2MC's teacher-researchers are involved in teaching at the Faculty of Health (Medicine, Pharmacy, Odontology), the Faculty of Science and Engineering and the Faculty of Sport and Human Movement Sciences, enabling high-quality recruitment and supervision of students. The I2MC is part of the Toulouse Biology, Health and Biotechnology Doctoral School.
